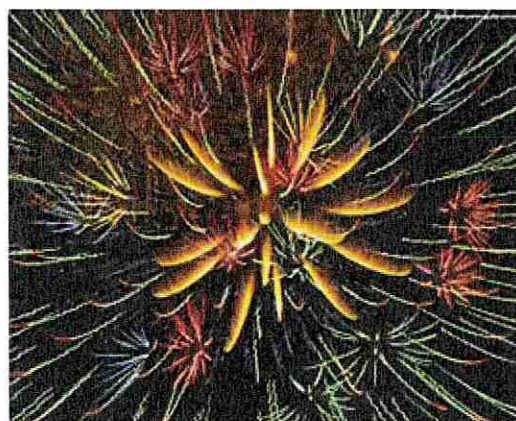


### Mufti Day - Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November

### Swimming

4KW will begin swimming lessons on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> November. These lessons will take each Wednesday up to and including Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December. Children should come to school in their PE kit and bring their swimming costume and towel with them. All children will need a packed lunch on the days they go swimming. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and would like the School Kitchen to prepare a packed lunch, please collect a form from the School Office.

### Educational Visits to School and School Trips

Over the course of the academic year, the school has in the past tried to arrange for each year group to go on a school trip and/or to invite organisations in to school who can provide a unique educational experience for the children. When such trips or visits are arranged, we ask parents/carers for a voluntary contribution towards the costs. The amount suggested is the total amount of the trip divided by the total number of children in the class/year group/s involved. The trips/visits are of educational value, and children are not treated differently according to whether or not their parent/carer has contributed to the cost. However, we are finding that increasingly the school is having to subsidise greater and greater shortfalls, which we

are no longer able to sustain. Therefore, any future trips/visits will only be able to go ahead if sufficient donations are received. Payments received for any activities/trips that are cancelled will be reimbursed immediately the cancellation is announced.

#### **Collecting Children at the End of the Day**

If you come in to school at the end of the day to collect your child, please can you ensure that they remain with you and are supervised by you once the teacher has released them to you. In particular, we ask Keystage 1 parents/carers to keep their children with them while they wait for their children from Keystage 2. Children are not allowed to go off to play on the lower playground or the adventure playground while waiting. Thank you for your co-operation with this matter.

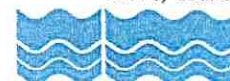

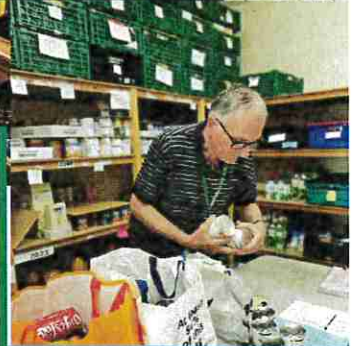
